Roads Australia - National Policy Priorities

1. Sustainability / Liveability

- Greater collaboration in planning (local/state governments)
- Integrated transport and land use planning – multi-modal, outcome-focused, corridor preservation and management
- Local government collaboration and reform
- Focus on economic/social outcomes e.g. active travel

2. Public perception of the value of infrastructure

- Customer experience, segmentation, customer communication
- Services for customers, predictable journeys
- Grow community understanding about value of infrastructure
- Highlight infrastructure project case studies that improve amenity and liveability

3. Disruptive mechanisms

- Regulation / compliance / standards
- Efficiency of network use
- Connected/autonomous vehicles, car sharing

4. Traffic management at road worksites / road safety systems

- Signage, replace workers, enforcement, training and accreditation
- Accountability / reduce serious injuries / reduce rural road speeds
- Safer vehicles / technology

5. Land transport market reform

6. Road asset management / maintenance

- Efficient delivery, value for money, improving service (spatial technology)
- Integrated transport network management (cradle to grave)
- Performance-based outcomes
