Long Distance vs Short Distance



- Interstate road freight represents only 4% 5% of the total freight moved
- Intrastate road freight represent 14% 15% of total freight moved
- 80% of all road freight moves less than 100km
- Average length of road haul is 86 km
- 96% of urban freight moves by road
