### Temporary Skills Shortage (TSS) Visa – Eligibility

Requirements



- Police clearance(s) required for every country lived in for more than 12 months exemptions for accredited sponsors
- English language testing requirement of 4.5/5 in IELTS
- English exemptions only for intra-company transferees earning base salary above \$96,400 per annum

#### **Labour Market Testing** Requirements

- LMT required for all TSS unless restricted by international trade agreements
- LMT requirements: advertising for 4 weeks within last 4 months.

#### **Occupation Classification**

- Short Term Skills Occupation List (STSOL) - 2 years
- Medium and Long Term Strategic Skilled List (MLTSSL) - 4 years
- Revised every six months
- Some occupations have additional caveats that must be met

#### Training Requirements and Fees

- Training levy requirement per nomination per year of \$1200 or \$1800
- Visa fees for long-term stream TSS to nearly double (\$2400)
- Visa fees for short-term stream TSS to increase (\$1150)

#### 2 Years Relevant Experience

- Must provide evidence of at least two years experience in nominated occupation
- five years
- Can include some work done in academic environments (PhD, etc.)

#### Salary

- Introduction of Annual Market Salary Rate (AMSR)
- Must be benchmarked against awards, equivalent Australian employee or job outlook data
- Not required for annual earnings above \$250,000

- Must have been completed in last

# International Trade Obligations – Labour Market Testing Exemptions

Citizenship

If the nominee is a citizen of Japan, Thailand, Mexico, China, Chile, South Korea, Singapore, Vietnam or New Zealand.

Citizens & Permanent Residents

If the nominee is a permanent resident of Canada, Chile, South Korea, Singapore or New Zealand. 3

Executives or Senior Managers as intracompany transfers

If the nominee is a

Visa Renewals

If the nominee is a citizen of a WTO member country and has worked for sponsor in the nominated position in Australia on a full-time basis for the last two years.

Associated Entities (ASEAN)

If the nominee is employed by an associated entity of sponsor and business is located in Brunei, Chile, China, Myanmar, Cambodia, Laos, Malaysia, Japan, New Zealand, Philippines, South Korea, Singapore, Thailand or Vietnam.


If the nominee is an Executive or Senior Manager\*\* and will be nominated by an Overseas Business Sponsor who operates in a WTO member country and will be responsible for the establishment of a new operation of that business in Australia.

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<sup>\*\*</sup>Under Department policy, these occupations include Chief Executive Officer or Managing Director, Chief Information Officer, Advertising Manager, Corporate General Manager, Finance Manager, Corporate Services Manager, HR Manager, Sales and Marketing Manager, Supply and Distribution Manager.

#### **REGIONAL INCENTIVES**

- Introduction of three new visas in November 2019
- Subclass 494 Regional Employer Sponsored Visa
- Designated Regional Areas outside of Melbourne, Sydney, Brisbane/Gold Coast, and Perth
- Valid for 5 years with pathway to Permanent Residence (3 year regional residence requirement)
